This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into and effective as of 16.12.2021 by and between:

Basirhat college. The college began its journey on November 16, 1947. The institution is currently operating in three shifts - morning, day, and evening - to accommodate a large number of male and female students from villages and towns such as Taki, Hingalgunge, Jogeshgunj, Samsernagar, Katihat, Deganga, Haroa, Baduria, and Berachampa who are pursuing bachelor's degrees in Arts, Science, and Commerce. Currently, the institution offers UG courses affiliated with the West Bengal State University in a total of 16 subjects, in addition to offering Postgraduate courses in Bengali. In addition, the college has a local NPTEL chapter.

Kalyani Mahavidyalaya . Kalyani Mahavidyalaya(KM) is a NAAC Accredited college, established in 1999 under Section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956. It is affiliated to the University of Kalyani and situated at City Centre Complex of Kalyani - the Educational Hub of West Bengal. The college campus, strategically located in proximity to Kalyani Shilpachal Railway Station, is a sprawling Eco-Friendly Campus built on 3.43 Acres of land. The college other than imparting instructions through Twenty (20) Honours and Program courses in different fields of Science, Humanities, and Commerce, caters to the students through centralized and digitized facilities- Digitized Central Library, Central Instrumentation Laboratory, Common Computer Centre, Language Laboratory, ICT Enabled Smart Classrooms and Seminar Halls. The college also provides Wi-Fi throughout the campus.

Cells and Committees as per UGC Mandate (Anti Ragging Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, RTI Cell, Internal Complaints Committee, and Career Counselling Cell etc.) are operative and provide students with the necessary support. Additionally, there are Health Centre, Help Desk and Rail & Ramp for Divyangjan Students, Elevator and Cafeteria.

The college excels in its academic endeavour, sports, cultural activities and community services. Through more than ten Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) with other Institutes, exchange of Academic Support Facilities, Internships, Training & Placements etc.; a pool of Add-On Courses for Skill Development and Career Advancement of the Students; Open and Distance Learning through NSOU Study Centre; Social Outreach Programmes through an active NSS Unit and a vibrant NCC Unit; and a rich department of Physical Education with Legacy of achieving Medals and Prizes in Games and Sports Activities in State and National Level Competitions; and extracurricular/ Cultural activities throughout the year, the college seeks to ensure its steady progress and all round development.

Scope:

This Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that the institutions wish to explore the possibility of collaborating together in various ways including:

- (a) Exchange of information and knowledge;
- (b) Mutual exchange of students involving all the academic departments with respect to the courses as offered by both the colleges;
- (c) Faculty exchange will be given special emphasis between the two organizations;
- (d) Development of joint research activities – while implementing the same, research personnel of both the institutes will adhere to the rules and regulations, as laid down time to time by the Government, affiliating Universities and national regulatory bodies;
- (e) To organize joint activities like Seminars/ Symposia/ Conference/ Workshop/ Webinar etc. – both the institutes will collaborate on designing and holding the aforementioned activities for dissemination of social and scientific information;
- (f) The colleges shall extend their academic resources and facilities available on a collaborative basis in the field of academics, education and research;

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- (g) Joint research publication by students/ teachers/ researchers of the partner institutes shall be encouraged;
- (h) Library resources may be shared for providing support in capacity building of the faculty, and for improvement of their teaching and research skills;
- (i) Joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of the intellectual property arising out of collaborative activities;
- (j) Provide internship opportunities to the students;

Terms of the MoU:



The terms of Understanding for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both the colleges prior to the initiation of that activity. Such agreements will have full regard to issues of quality assurance and budgetary matters and may be subject to legal contracts as agreed by the institutes.

This MOU shall be valid for a period of 5 years. It may be amended, modified, extended, or renewed only by the written consent of both institutions. The organizations agree to review this agreement six months prior to the end of the 5-year term. This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by 6 months' notice by either college.




