Apart from that, this college offers facilities for Open and Distance Learning through NSOU Study Centre. Social Outreach Programmes are operative through an active NSS Unit and a vibrant NCC Unit. The college has legacy of achieving Medals and Prizes in Games and Sports Activities in State and National Level Competitions. Through these extracurricular and Cultural activities throughout the year, the college seeks to ensure its steady progress and all round development.

**Hooghly Women's College** is a Government-aided, UGC Recognized, Women's arts and Sciences College, affiliated to the University of Burdwan. It is located in the Hooghly district of West Bengal, India. It is the first women's college of the district. During inception of the college, classes of first year started on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 1949, with only 41 students and four teachers in the tiny building of Mission House. The main building started functioning in 1952. Presently, the institution has 9 departments in Humanities and 8 departments in Science.

The curriculum offered by the college allows the students to get exposed to cross-cutting issues covering a range of topics on professional skill development, Equal Opportunity Cell, psychological counselling, career counselling among other things. All the science departments are equipped with adequate instruments in the laboratories. There is a central library which abounds in rare and good books besides reading room facility and seminar library for each department.

The college is proud to have a whole set of dedicated faculty members ensuring expertise and quality education across disciplines. As part of commitment to supporting the students; the college provides a host of scholarships and memorial awards to pupils. Quite a number of the students secure placements or progress to higher education, reflecting their readiness for entering the professional world. This institution has taken great initiative and the faculties have duly prepared themselves for the implementation of NEP-2020, and are committed to becoming a holistic multidisciplinary establishment, striving for excellence in all domains.

**Scope:**

This Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that the institutions wish to explore the possibility of collaborating together in various ways including:

- (a) Exchange of information and knowledge;
- (b) Mutual exchange of students involving all the academic departments with respect to the courses as offered by both the colleges;
- (c) Faculty exchange will be given special emphasis between the two organizations;
- (d) Development of joint research activities – while implementing the same, research personnel of both the institutes will adhere to the rules and regulations, as laid down time to time by the Government, affiliating Universities and national regulatory bodies;
- (e) To organize joint activities like Seminars/ Symposia/ Conference/ Workshop/ Webinar, Vocational courses etc. – both the institutes will collaborate on designing and holding the aforementioned activities for dissemination of social and scientific information;
- (f) The colleges shall extend their academic resources and facilities available on a collaborative basis in the field of academics, education and research;
- (g) Joint research publication by students/ teachers/ researchers of the partner institutes shall be encouraged;
- (h) Library resources may be shared for providing support in capacity building of the faculty, and for improvement of their teaching and research skills;
- (i) Joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of the intellectual property arising out of collaborative activities;
- (j) Provide internship opportunities to the students;

**Terms of the MoU:**

The terms of Understanding for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both the colleges prior to the initiation of that activity. Such agreements will have full regard to issues of quality assurance and budgetary matters and may be subject to legal contracts as agreed by the institutes.


