

Kalyani Mahavidyalaya, established in 1999, is aGovernment-Aided, UGC Recognized, NAAC Accredited college, Affiliated to the University of Kalyani. It is situated at City Centre Complex of Kalyani - the Educational Hub of West Bengal. The college, strategically located in proximity to Kalyani Shilpanchal Railway Station, has a sprawling Eco-Friendly Campus on 3.43 Acres of land. Apart from imparting instructions through Twenty (20) Honours/ Major and Program courses in different fields of Science, Humanities, and Commerce, this college caters to the students through centralized and digitized facilities- Digitized Central Library, Central Instrumentation Laboratory, Common Computer Centre, Language Laboratory, ICT Enabled Smart Classrooms and Seminar Halls. The college also provides Wi-Fi throughout the campus.

Cells and Committees as per UGC Mandate (such as Anti Ragging Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, RTI Cell, Internal Complaints Committee, and Career Counselling Cell etc.) are operative and provide students with the necessary support. Additionally, there are central facilities such as Health Centre, Cafeteria, Help Desk along with Rail & Ramp and Elevator for Divyangjan Students.

The college excelsin its academic endeavour, sports, cultural activities and community services. There areseveral Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) with other Institutes for exchange of Academic Support Facilities, Internships, Training & Placements etc. Pools of Add-On Courses are available for Skill Development and Career Advancement of the Students. Apart from that, this college offers facilities for Open and Distance Learning through NSOU Study Centre. Social Outreach Programmes are operative through an active NSS Unit and a vibrant NCC Unit. The college has legacy of achieving Medals and Prizes in Games and Sports Activities in State and National Level Competitions. Through these extracurricular and Cultural activities throughout the year, the college seeks to ensure its steady progress and all-round development.

Katwa College, is a Government of West Bengal aided, UGC Recognized, NAAC accredited, co-educational, general degree college, affiliated to the University of Burdwan. Established in the year 1948, this college, through its 75 years of glorious existence, has achieved the status of being the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest affiliated college under the University. To cater to the ever-increasing demand from students, currently, the college runs in 2 shifts – Morning and Day. The Day section offers 3-year under-graduate Honours and General courses in Humanities, Science, and Commerce; as well as one-year B-Ed course. The Morning section is dedicated specially for female learners who want to pursue general course in humanities. Seven Science, eight humanities, and the commerce departmentsalong with the central library, with a rich collection of more than forty thousand books and journals, fulfil the course-oriented academic needs of students from all streams. The college actively pursues advancement of higher learning in the region by facilitating operation of NSOU and RBU study centres from its campus. The bilingual, biannual, multidisciplinary journal 'String,' B-Ed deptt. Magazine 'Anandadhara', and the college magazine give tangible form to the pluralistic views on culture, society, and science, nurtured by the dynamic scholastic environment of this institution.

# Scope:

This Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that the institutions wish to explore the possibility of collaborating together in various ways including:

- (a) Exchange of information and knowledge;
- (b) Mutual exchange of students involving all the academic departments with respect to the courses as offered by both the colleges;
- (c) Faculty exchange will be given special emphasis between the two organizations;
- (d) Development of joint research activities while implementing the same, research personnel of both the institutes will adhere to the rules and regulations, as laid down time to time by the Government, affiliating Universities and national regulatory bodies;
- (e) To organize joint activities like Seminars/ Symposia/ Conference/ Workshop/ Webinar, Vocational courses etc. – both the institutes will collaborate on designing and holding the aforementioned activities for dissemination of social and scientific information;
- (f) The colleges shall extend their academic resources and facilities available on a collaborative basis in the field of academics, education and research;
- (g) Joint research publication by students/ teachers/ researchers of the partner institutes shall be encouraged;
- (h) Library resources may be shared for providing support in capacity building of the faculty, and for improvement of their teaching and research skills;
- Joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of the intellectual property arising out of collaborative activities;
- (j) Provide internship opportunities to the students.

## Terms of the MoU:

The terms of Understanding for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both the colleges prior to the initiation of that

activity. Such agreements will have full regard to issues of quality assurance and budgetary matters and may be subject to legal contracts as agreed by the institutes.

This MOU shall be valid for a period of5 years. It may be amended, modified, extended, or renewed only by the written consent of both institutions. The organizations agree to review this agreement six months prior to the end of the 5-year term. This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by 6 months' notice by either college.

## Disputes:

If any dispute arises in respect of the MoU, in that case both the organizations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
