

Kalyani Mahavidyalaya, a NAAC Accredited college, established in 1999, under Section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956, is affiliated to the University of Kalyani. It is situated at City Centre Complex of Kalyani - the Educational Hub of West Bengal. The college, strategically located in proximity to Kalyani Shilpanchal Railway Station, has a sprawling Eco-Friendly Campus on 3.43 Acres of land. The college, other than imparting instructions through Twenty (20) Honours and Programcourses in different fields of Science, Humanities, and Commerce, caters to the students through centralized and digitized facilities- Digitized Central Library, Central Instrumentation Laboratory, Common Computer Centre, Language Laboratory, ICT Enabled Smart Classrooms and Seminar Halls. The college also provides Wi-Fi throughout the campus.

Cells and Committees as per UGC Mandate (such as Anti Ragging Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, RTI Cell, Internal Complaints Committee, and Career Counselling Cell etc.) are operative and provide students with the necessary support. Additionally, there are central facilities such as Health Centre, Cafeteria, Help Desk along with Rail & Ramp and Elevator for Divyangjan Students.

The college excelsin its academic endeavour, sports, cultural activities and community services. There are several Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) with other Institutes for exchange of Academic Support Facilities, Internships, Training& Placements etc. Pools of Add-On Courses are available for Skill Development and Career Advancement of the Students. Apart from that, this college offers facilities for Open and Distance Learning through NSOU Study Centre. Social Outreach Programmes are operative through an active NSS Unit and a vibrant NCC Unit. The college has legacy of achieving Medals and Prizes in Games and Sports Activities in State and National Level Competitions. Through these extracurricular and Cultural activities throughout the year, the college seeks to ensure its steady progress and all round development.

Kanchrapara College, a NAAC Accredited, GoWB aided Degree & Post Graduate college, under the University of Kalyaniat Kanchrapara, 24 Parganas (North) – 743145, West Bengal, Indiais carrying the legacy of spreading of education among the common people of the locality. The college started its journey on 13th Nov, 1972 with a meagre number of only 32 students with affiliation of only Pre-University class. In course of time the college has grown up to full maturity.

The college now has a number of more than 6000 students with Honors in 21 subjects in Science, Arts and Commerce division. The class of Science and Arts stream takes place in day shift. Commerce section runs in Evening shift. Both BA general and B.Com general and Honors courses are running in Evening shift. Apart from a good number of devoted Non-Teaching Staff whose service is available for 24 hours, there is a band of highly qualified teachers whose scholarly guidance and advice is always available for the students.

Besides the traditional core subjects there are also honors course in some new emerging subjects like Environmental Science, Molecular Biology and Biotechnology, Microbiology, Food and Nutrition, Computer Science etc.

Post-Graduation in Hindi is also running in this college for a few years. The college has a Study Centre under the Distance Education Directorate, University of Kalyani where M.A. in Bengali, English, History and Education is taught in the same premises on Sundays and Holidays. With all the basic amenities like Students' Common Room, Gymnasium, Playground, Net Resource Centre etc the College each year attracts a large number of students from the surrounding areas and makes its presence felt in the academia by the good results each year the students attain.

Scope:

This Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that the institutions wish to explore the possibility of collaborating together in various ways including:

- (a) Exchange of information and knowledge;
- (b) Mutual exchange of students involving all the academic departments with respect to the courses as offered by both the colleges;
- (c) Faculty exchange will be given special emphasis between the two organizations;
- (d) Development of joint research activities while implementing the same, research personnel of both the institutes will adhere to the rules and regulations, as laid down time to time by the Government, affiliating Universities and national regulatory bodies;
- (e) To organize joint activities like Seminars/ Symposia/ Conference/ Workshop/ Webinar, Vocational courses etc. – both the institutes will collaborate on designing and holding the aforementioned activities for dissemination of social and scientific information;
- (f) The colleges shall extend their academic resources and facilities available on a collaborative basis in the field of academics, education and research;
- (g) Joint research publication by students/ teachers/ researchers of the partner institutes shall be encouraged;
- (h) Library resources may be shared for providing support in capacity building of the faculty, and for improvement of their teaching and research skills;
- (i) Joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of the intellectual property arising out of collaborative activities;
- (i) Provide internship opportunities to the students;

Terms of the MoU:

The terms of Understanding for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both the colleges

prior to the initiation of that activity. Such agreements will have full regard to issues of quality assurance and budgetary matters and may be subject to legal contracts as agreed by the institutes.

This MOU shall be valid for a period of5 years. It may be amended, modified, extended, or renewed only by the written consent of both institutions. The organizations agree to review this agreement six months prior to the end of the 5-year term. This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by 6 months' notice by either college.

Disputes:

If any dispute arises in respect of the MoU, in that case both the organizations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
